Tom has been able to obtain four **Flood Defence Packs**, each pack contains 30 reusable water bags which can be strung together to form a wall to either stop or divert flood water. Also 15 self-inflating hessian bags which activate on contact with water and 4 large zipped bags capable of containing goods the size of a settee.
